



Student Attendance Expectations and Absence Reasons and Codes

Suzuki Charter School strongly encourages all students to attend school regularly and punctually in order to enhance the likelihood of successful learning. The *School Act* provides the provincial expectations related to student attendance at school and defines what reasons may legitimately keep students away from school. Section 13(5) of this act excuses a student from attending school only if due to: sickness, religious holiday, suspension/expulsion, bereavement, permission from a School Board, or other unavoidable circumstances. Please note that family holidays, extension of school vacation periods, or parental permission given to a student to stay away from school are not considered to be an excused absence. If a student is chronically absent from school for “unexcused” reasons, the school will be following up with parents by letters home, parent/principal phone calls, and/or meetings with the classroom teacher, parent, and principal. The following is a list of student absence reasons and codes utilized by Suzuki Charter School which align with the *School Act*:

Absent Excused	Reason conforms with school act: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Illness: student is ill • Isolation: student is isolating per CMOH orders • Medical: Any medical/dental other than illness including: appointments, surgery, recovery, physiotherapy, specialized medical etc. • Religious Holiday: school day is a holiday in student’s religion • Bereavement - death in family, funeral etc. • Unavoidable circumstances: legal or safety issues (school will make note of reason) • Suspension - student is suspended from school 		AE

Parent Aware	School notified by parent with reason not conforming to school act: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vacation - student is away during operational days on vacation • Isolation - student is isolating upon return from travel per Federal or Provincial Health orders • Parent is choosing to keep child home • Miscellaneous: student/parent is tired, road conditions or weather, parent is ill, flat tire etc. 	Unexcused	PA

Late Excused	School notified by parent with reason conforming to school act: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medical/Dental or other appointments conforming to school act • Funeral or religious event 		LE
Late Unexcused	No reason given or reason not conforming to school act (traffic/slept in etc.)	Unexcused	LU
